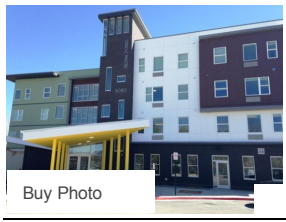


# Redtail Ponds up for 'people's choice' housing award

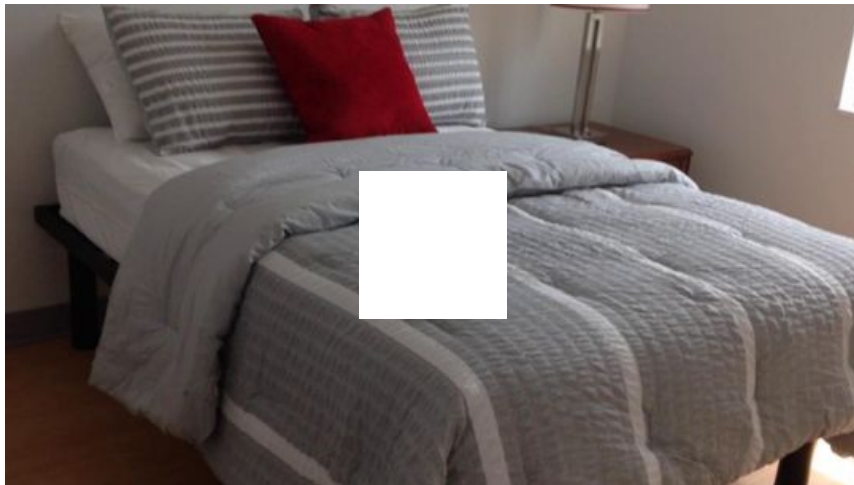

The 60-unit Fort Collins Housing Authority permanent supportive housing and affordable housing development located in south Fort Collins is one of nine affordable housing projects up for the award.

Redtail Ponds is fully leased, with 25 units rented to formerly homeless individuals with a disability, 15 units rented to previously homeless veterans and 20 units rented to low to low/moderate income individuals.
