Built in 2015, **Redtail Ponds** was Northern Colorado's first **Permanent Supportive Housing** community. Developed and managed by Housing Catalyst, Redtail offers 60 apartments for people with disabilities who have experienced homelessness. Multiple support services located onsite help people gain stability in their lives and develop a community of healing.
